Youth Aviation Scholarship

The Bremerton Pilots Association is offering a \$5,500 aviation scholarship for young people in the greater Puget Sound area who have the desire to obtain a private pilot certificate. This Scholarship is made possible through donations and fund-raising activities by the Bremerton Pilots Association, the Port of Bremerton, and friends of aviation in the community.

Youth Scholarship Application

1. Qualifications for Scholarship Fund Award

- a. Aspiring pilots who are at least 16 years of age, or at least 15 years of age if pursuing a glider category rating, and who have not yet reached their 30th birthday, are encouraged to submit an application.
- b. Applicants must **not** have completed their first solo prior to the in-person interview.
- c. Applicants must reside and train in the greater Puget Sound area.
- d. Selection Criteria:
 - i. Serious about obtaining a Private Pilot Certificate.
 - ii. Shows good character, discipline, and attitude.
 - iii. Currently has, and is likely to maintain, an above average scholastic grade point average (minimum GPA 3.0 on a 4.0 scale).
 - iv. Demonstrates an aptitude for flight training through successful involvement and/or completion of similar activities.
 - v. Shows a clear commitment to completing his/her training.
 - vi. Can meet the time parameters of the program.

2. Application Procedure

- a. Scholarship applications are reviewed twice a year, in January and May. Applicants are then selected for in-person interviews to be held at the Bremerton National Airport in early February and June. Scholarship recipients are then selected and notified shortly after the interview.
- b. Applications must be received by the scholarship committee before January 1st to be considered for the February interview and before May 1st for the June interview.
- c. Download and fill out the online scholarship application and submit it along with your high school and college transcripts at BremertonPilotsAssociation.org.

3. Funding Structure

- a. Students awarded a scholarship must pass the Private Pilot Checkride within one year of being selected as a scholarship recipient. Extensions will not be granted.
- b. A \$5,500 check from the Bremerton Pilots Association Scholarship Fund will be presented to the new pilot on successful completion of paragraph (3a) above.
- c. Scholarship recipients will be expected to join the Bremerton Pilots Association.
