**1. Qualifications for Scholarship Fund Award**

- a. Young men and women who are at least 16-1/2 years of age, and who have not yet reached their 30<sup>th</sup> birthday, are encouraged to submit an application.
  - i. Applicants 30 years of age and older will be considered on a case by case basis depending on availability of funding.
- b. Applicants must reside in the greater Puget Sound Area.
- c. Selection Criteria:
  - i. Serious about obtaining a Private Pilot License.
  - ii. Shows good character.
  - iii. Currently has, and is likely to maintain, an above average scholastic average (minimum GPA 3.0 on a 4.0 scale).
  - iv. Demonstrates an aptitude for flight training through successful involvement and/or completion of similar activities.
  - v. Shows good discipline and attitude.
  - vi. Shows a clear commitment to completing his/her training.
  - vii. Can meet the time parameters of the program.

**2. Application Procedure**

- a. Applications are processed as received.
- b. Completely fill out the Scholarship Application and submit it via regular mail, email, or deliver it to the Port of Bremerton office at Bremerton National Airport.
- c. Submit your latest high school or college transcript.

**3. Funding Structure**

- a. Students who are awarded a Scholarship must begin their training within 30 days of the award and pass the Private Pilot Checkride within 180 days.
- b. A \$3500.00 check from the Bremerton Pilots Association Scholarship Fund will be presented to the student on successful completion of paragraph (3a) above.
- c. At the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, an extension may be granted for extenuating circumstances if this request is received in writing prior to the paragraph (3a) deadline.
